FAQ's

Can anyone audition, even if they have never been in a production before?

Yes, anyone who meets the minimum age requirement listed in the audition notice are encouraged to audition. It is perfectly fine if you have little or no experience! At The Stage Theater Co., we welcome everyone and anyone who wants to be a part of something magical.

What if I want to help with tech (set design, lights, costumes, etc.) with the show versus being the cast?

Putting on a production truly takes a village, and we need more than just a cast! Please contact us and we will get you in contact with our tech team for the production.

What if I do not want a solo, and do I have to sing by myself in auditions?

That is perfectly okay! When filling out your audition form, clarify what you feel comfortable doing, and we will stay within the boundaries you set. If you do not feel like seeing by yourself-no problem! This applies to dancing and speaking parts as well. We want to make sure everyone feels comfortable and wants to participate.

What do I need to wear to auditions?

Be sure to wear something you can move in and feel comfortable in. Please do not wear anything restrictive, itchy, or could be bothersome or a distraction.

Can you tell me about rehearsals?

Absolutely! All our rehearsals will occur at The Floor Dance Studio (the same as auditions). When filling out your audition form, you will put any conflicts you may have, and we will do our best to make sure rehearsals fit your schedule. Do not worry if you already have conflicts or something planned during rehearsals, we will work it out! If you do miss a rehearsal, we just ask that you follow up with a cast member or on the cast hub to see what you missed.
